### Camp Staff

In order to best service our campers, staff undergo a week long training session as well as on-going staff development and evaluations.

### Financial Assistance

Our annual Reach-Out campaign helps to keep tuition reasonable while allowing us to provide quality programming. Through the YMCA's ACCESS Program, we offer reduced rates to individuals and families who cannot afford the full price of camp. Eligibility is based on income level, family size and funds available.
